TOBACCO PRODUCT FLAVORS: A POLICY REVIEW

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Background

Bans or restrictions on flavors in tobacco products can reduce the appeal and use of tobacco products.

The aim of this study was to determine which countries prohibit flavored tobacco products and the details of those restrictions in order to identify possible gaps and opportunities for these and other countries to address.

Methods

- National-level flavor policies were identified from grey literature, scanned news articles, and consultation with key informants
- Policies were reviewed for their stated rationale, terms and definitions of flavors, tobacco products covered, and restrictions on the use of flavor descriptors (imagery and terms) on tobacco product packaging

Results

Eleven countries and the EU have identified with a national-level tobacco product flavor policy.


Recommendations

Existing policies could be strengthened by prohibiting menthol and "concept" flavors – as well as having explicit restrictions on descriptors, images and coloring on the packaging that may be perceived as a flavor, sensation, taste or aroma.



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Eleven countries and the EU have a tobacco product flavor policy. Countries consistently prohibit fruity, vanilla and spicy flavors; most include menthol.
